Title of Proposed Ordinance:

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE FIFTH AMENDMENT TO THE 2016 BUDGET AND AUTHORIZING CHANGES IN APPROPRIATIONS FOR YEAR 2016 TO PERMIT THE DISTRIBUTION OF 2015 EXCESS TABOR REVENUES ONLY IN THE EVENT THE ELECTORATE DOES NOT APPROVE A REVENUE CHANGE AT THE NOVEMBER 8, 2016 COORDINATED ELECTION

Subject Matter Summary:

The proposed Ordinance approves supplemental appropriation changes to the 2016 Budget to accommodate expenditures associated with the rebate of 2015 TABOR surplus revenues in the event that the TABOR ballot question to the electorate on November 8 fails.

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE FIFTH AMENDMENT TO THE 2016 BUDGET AND AUTHORIZING CHANGES IN APPROPRIATIONS FOR YEAR 2016 TO PERMIT THE DISTRIBUTION OF 2015 EXCESS TABOR REVENUES ONLY IN THE EVENT THE ELECTORATE DOES NOT APPROVE A REVENUE CHANGE AT THE NOVEMBER 8, 2016 COORDINATED ELECTION

WHEREAS by Ordinance No. 2015-48 revenues and expenditures for the year 2016 were budgeted and appropriated,

WHEREAS, in 2015 the Town received revenues in excess of applicable revenue and spending limits imposed under Article X, Section 20 of the Colorado Constitution (TABOR),

WHEREAS, the Castle Rock electorate will decide at the coordinated election on November 8, 2016 on whether a revenue change should be approved to allow the retention of such excess revenues ("Revenue Change"),

WHEREAS, if the Revenue Change is not authorized by the electorate, a refund of such excess revenue must be made in 2016 necessitating a corresponding budget amendment.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CASTLE ROCK, COLORADO:

Section 1. Amendment and Appropriation. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 2015-48 is amended to reflect the budgeting and appropriation of aggregate 2016 revenues and expenditures to the respective Funds as follows:

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Section 2. Contingent Effect. The budget amendment effected by this Ordinance shall only be given effect in the event the Castle Rock electorate does not approve the Revenue Change. If the Revenue Change is approved this budget amendment shall be of force or effect.

Section 3. Amendment. This Ordinance shall constitute the Fifth Amendment to the 2016 Budget, adopted by Ordinance No. 2015-48.

Section 4. Severability. If any clause, sentence, paragraph, or part of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstances shall for any reason be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction invalid, such judgment shall not affect the remaining provisions of this ordinance.

Section 5. Safety Clause. The Town Council finds and declares that this Ordinance is promulgated and adopted for the public health, safety and welfare and this Ordinance bears a rational relation to the legislative object sought to be obtained.
