Pursuant of Section 7-3 of the Town of Castle Rock Home Rule Charter, notice is hereby given that the Town Council will consider adoption of the following named and described ordinance during its meeting on October 18, 2016 at 6:00 P.M. at the Town of Castle Rock, Town Hall, 100 North Wilcox, Castle Rock, CO 80104.

Title of Proposed Ordinance:

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE SEVENTH AMENDMENT TO THE 2016 BUDGET AND AUTHORIZING CHANGES IN APPROPRIATIONS FOR YEAR 2016 TO FUND THE POSSIBLE ISSUANCE OF A CONTRACT FOR FESTIVAL PARK EXPANSION PROJECT, PROVIDING FOR ITS EMERGENCY ADOPTION ON SECOND AND FINAL READING

Subject Matter Summary:

The proposed Ordinance approves supplemental appropriation changes to the 2016 Budget to accommodate expenditures associated with construction costs for Festival Park, should the Town Council take action to approve a contract for this project.

Emergency Adoption is requested on second and final reading to assure adequate funding will be in place at the time the contract, if any, for the Festival Park Expansion project is approved by Town Council

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE SEVENTH AMENDMENT TO THE 2016 BUDGET AND AUTHORIZING CHANGES IN APPROPRIATIONS FOR YEAR 2016 TO FUND THE POSSIBLE ISSUANCE OF A CONTRACT FOR FESTIVAL PARK EXPANSION PROJECT, PROVIDING FOR ITS EMERGENCY ADOPTION ON SECOND AND FINAL READING

WHEREAS by Ordinance No. 2015-48 revenues and expenditures for the year 2016 were budgeted and appropriated,

WHEREAS, supplemental appropriation of revenues is authorized under Article IX of the Castle Rock Home Rule Charter, upon certification of the Town Manager of the availability of such revenues,

WHEREAS, it is necessary to adopt this ordinance on an emergency basis on second and final reading to ensure adequate funds are allocated to support payment under the construction contract for the Festival Park Expansion project.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CASTLE ROCK, COLORADO:

Section 1. Amendment and Appropriation. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 2015-48 is amended to reflect the budgeting and appropriation of aggregate 2016 revenues and expenditures to the respective Funds as follows:

Section 2. Amendment. This Ordinance shall constitute the Seventh Amendment to the 2016 Budget, adopted by Ordinance No. 2015-48.

Section 3. Severability. If any clause, sentence, paragraph, or part of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstances shall for any reason be adjudged by a court of

competent jurisdiction invalid, such judgment shall not affect the remaining provisions of this ordinance.

Section 4. Safety Clause. The Town Council finds and declares that this Ordinance is promulgated and adopted for the public health, safety and welfare and this Ordinance bears a rational relation to the legislative object sought to be obtained.

Section 5. Emergency Clause. For the reasons stated in the recitals to this Ordinance, it is declared that an emergency exists and it is necessary for the preservation of the immediate public health and safety for this Ordinance to take effect upon its adoption.
