Re: Petition to Amend the Town of Castle Rock Home Rule Charter

Dear Petition Representatives:

Pursuant to C.R.S. § 31-2-221(1), the form of the three petitions to amend the Town of Castle Rock Home Rule Charter resubmitted by you and received by the Town on April 13, 2017 are hereby APPROVED.

Section 31-2-210(1)(a)(IV) of the Colorado Revised Statutes requires a petition to submit a charter amendment at a special election to be signed by at least ten percent (10%) of the registered electors of the Town registered on the date of filing the statement of intent. The Douglas County Clerk advised that on April 10, 2017, there were 42,876 registered electors in the Town of Castle Rock; therefore, the petition will require at least 4,288 signatures for it to be deemed sufficient.


With regard to petition circulation, please be aware that C.R.S. § 31-2-221(1) requires petitions to be prenumbered serially, and the circulation of any petition by any medium other than personally by a circulator is prohibited. Additionally, any disassembly of the petition that has the effect of separating the affidavits from the signatures shall render the petition invalid and of no force and effect. C.R.S. § 31-2-221(2).

Signed petitions must be filed with this office before the close of business on the ninetieth (90<sup>th</sup>) day after the date on which the statement of intent was filed; in this case, on Monday, July 10, 2017 because the 90<sup>th</sup> day is a Sunday. C.R.S. § 31-2-210(1)(a)(I).

Finally, my review is only of the petition form and does not extend to the subject matter of the petition, nor may this office provide you with legal advice. By approving the petition form, I make no findings as to the substance of the proposed amendments to the Home Rule Charter.
