## Community Service Programs for Court Ordered Community Service Participants

- ❖ You may perform your community service for **ANY** non-profit organization, governmental entity, or religious group. If you have a question about whether or not something qualifies under these guidelines, please call the Castle Rock Municipal Court **before** you do your community service. You can call the Court at 303-663-6123.
- ❖ **YOU NEED TO SCHEDULE YOUR COMMUNITY SERVICE AS SOON AS POSSIBLE!!!** Community service can be difficult to schedule, especially juvenile theft cases, and if you wait until the last possible moment you may not be able to finish it by your due date. If you are unable to contact a representative of one of the following organizations, we recommend you physically walk into the organization's office and speak with someone in person to schedule community service.
- ❖ It is **YOUR** responsibility to make sure your time sheet for your community service is filled out and filed with the Clerk's office at 100 N. Perry St. Castle Rock. This may be done in person, or via email attachment.
- ❖ A person's age, and whether the community service is court ordered, may affect opportunities.
