Community Service Program for Court ordered community service participants

- ❖ You may perform your community service for **ANY** non-profit organization, governmental entity, or religious group. If you have a question about whether or not something qualifies under these guidelines please call the Castle Rock Municipal Court **before** you do your community service. You can call the Community Service Coordinator at 303-663-6136.
- ❖ **YOU NEED TO SCHEDULE YOUR COMMUNITY SERVICE AS SOON AS POSSIBLE!!!** Community service can be difficult to schedule (especially juvenile theft cases) and if you wait until the last possible moment, you may not be able to finish it by your due date. If you are unable to "get a hold of" a representative of one of the following organizations and/or they do not return your calls/emails/messages, we recommend you physically walk into the organization's offices and speak with someone in person to schedule community service.
- ❖ It is **YOUR** responsibility to make sure your time sheet for your community service is filled out and filed with the Clerk's office at 100 N. Perry St. Castle Rock.
- ❖ You can take a CPR or First Aid class for your community service. You will be given hour for hour credit. For example, if the class is 10 hours long, you will receive 10 hours credit toward your community service. The Castle Rock Recreation Center does offer these classes. Call (303) 660-1036 for details.
- ❖ Attached is a list of possible places and contacts that accept community service participants.

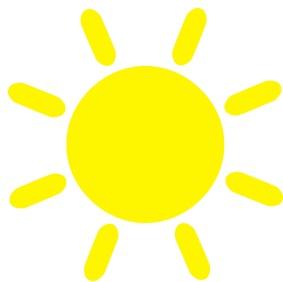
