## Spectator Code of Conduct

As a spectator of a Town of Castle Rock Athletics program:

- I will show respect for all participants, including players, coaches, officials and other spectators.
- I will set a positive example for young athletes by demonstrating good sportsmanship, respect and integrity.
- I will stay off the playing field or court during games and practices, unless I am asked for assistance by a coach or official. I will avoid interfering with the game in any way.
- I will encourage and support young athletes, regardless of whether they are on my team or the opposing team.
- I will follow the rules and policies set by the Town of Castle Rock, including those related to spectator behavior. I will avoid disruptive behavior such as smoking, drinking alcohol or using drugs at games or practices.
- I will respect the decisions of coaches and officials, even if I disagree with them. I will avoid arguing or confronting coaches or officials during or after games.
- I will avoid coaching from the sidelines or giving instructions from the sidelines during games or practices.
- I will cheer positively and in a supportive manner. I will avoid negative behavior such as booing, taunting or heckling.
- I will enjoy the game. I will remember that recreational youth sports are about having fun and enjoying the game, and will enjoy the experience and have a positive attitude, win or lose.

Should I as a spectator fail to adhere to this Code of Conduct, Athletics staff reserve the right to require disciplinary actions, including removal from future spectating opportunities.
